

Uniform Requirements and Providers

Student Uniform

All school skirts, trousers and shirts must be purchased from the authorised school uniform suppliers (Kenya Shirts and Image First). School uniforms should fit correctly. Clothing should be labelled. Students should have three complete sets of uniform. At least one PE shirt should be in the House colour.

1. **Trousers/Shorts/Skirts/Pinafore** – plain grey (PYP students wear shorts and pinafores).
2. **Shirt/Blouse** – PYP and MYP students wear the white school shirt/blouse. DP students wear the grey pinstripe school shirt/blouse.
3. **Shoes** – enclosed plain black shoes (low heel).
4. **Socks** – plain white/black/grey.
5. **Jumper/Hoodie** – plain grey with school logo or plain black or grey.
6. **Headscarves** – plain black, grey or white are permitted if worn for religious or cultural reasons.
7. **Caps** – may be worn during outdoor activities.

Physical Education (PE) Uniform

1. Black shorts, a grey school T-shirt and running shoes must be worn during physical education classes and any after-school sports activity.
2. One house T-shirt.

Grooming and Other Expectations

1. Hair must be kept clean and well-groomed.
2. Only naturally occurring colours may be used to dye hair (brown, black, blonde or auburn).
3. Braiding of hair is permitted if it is kept clean and well-groomed.
4. Beards and facial hair must be clean and well-groomed.
5. Natural-tone make-up and neutral-coloured nail polish should be minimal and not draw attention. Nails are to be kept well-groomed, practical and clean.
6. Jewellery should be kept to a minimum and be safe to wear for PE and other sporting and practical activities (e.g., no dangling earrings, loose bracelets or chains).
